















Removal of graffiti from porous unsealed surfaces (concrete, plaster, brick, etc.)

| Brush Graffi-Strip straight from the tub on to affected areas | Allow to work, wait 30 minutes to 4 hours | Agitate with a brush or abrasive pad working well into graffiti | Rinse off with plenty of water to neutralize residues | Check and repeat as necessary. If shadowing is present go to part 2 | Apply Ghost Remover generously by brush, airless spray or roller to affected areas | Allow to work for between 5-10 minutes | Wash off using high pressure water, very hot water (90°C) assists effectiveness of product. | |
